Before you start in September some transition work will be emailed to you. It is vital that you complete these assignments and activities, as they will help you to make the transition from GCSE to A Level.

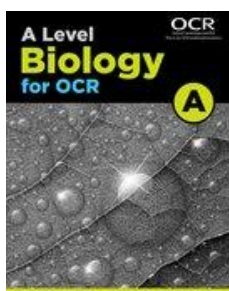
### Requirements

All students must have suitable stationary needed for laboratory work and exams, namely a scientific calculator, black ball point pens, pencils, sharpener and a 30cm ruler. You will also need lined paper and an A4 binder in which to keep organised lesson notes and worksheets. Highlighter pens, file dividers, post-it notes and plastic wallets are also very useful.

**For safety reasons all students studying a science A level will need a lab coat and goggles. Lab coats with studs (not buttons) can be purchased from Amazon.**

It would be very beneficial to have your own copy of the recommended text book.




