

Higher Education Advice and Guidance Process

November 2018

- Twilight session for potential applicants to the universities of Cambridge or Oxford or for highly competitive courses

February 2019

- Completion of online Centigrade Higher Education planning programme by all students

March 2019

- 12th: UCAS Conference Day for all students, including:
 - Feedback from the Centigrade app results and the chance to research findings and practise using the UCAS search facility
 - Talk from Director of Admissions at Bath University on selecting and applying to Universities using the UCAS process
 - Initial work on Personal Statements

June 2019

- Students applying for Medicine or Dentistry register for UKCAT admissions testing
- 11th: UCAS Information Evening
- 17th: UCAS Convention for Cambridgeshire at Newmarket Race Course
- TBC (poss 28th June): Schools' Taster Day at Leicester University

June/July 2019

- Official start of the UCAS process with online registration of all potential applicants
- Further opportunities to work with tutors on Personal Statements during Tutor Periods
- 8th –12th July (Futures Week): Opportunities to seek help and advice on any aspect of the UCAS application process from the Sixth Form Senior Leadership Team

August 2019

- 15th: A level results day
- Post-results discussions with the Sixth Form Leadership Team and confirmation of study plans for 2019-20

September 2019

- Within first week of term: Opportunities for students applying for early entry courses or institutions to receive additional support with completion of Personal Statements
- Guidance sessions and Personal Statement planning continues for all students until applications are submitted

October 2019

- 15th: UCAS deadline for receipt of applications to universities of Cambridge or Oxford and applications for medicine, dentistry and veterinary medicine/science

October/November 2019

- Students allocated a time to have their forms checked by staff for administrative errors. Please note that failure to attend these meetings without due notice will mean that forms are submitted without these checks
- Interviews begin and all applications are completed (internal deadline for completion of UCAS forms is Friday 22nd November 2019)
- Offers begin

January 2020

- 15th: Final application deadline for the receipt at UCAS of applications to all non-early entry courses
- Offers continue
- Selection advice and confirmation of first and second choice offers

August 2020

- 13th August -Post-results advice and clearing assistance given by the Sixth Form Leadership Team
