

## **Pre-entry Preparation and Requirements and Recommendations**

Welcome to Religion, Philosophy and Ethics at Comberton Sixth Form.

We follow the OCR A-level examination and will be studying for papers in Philosophy, Ethics and Developments in Christian Thought. This allows for a synoptic approach across these topics, with each aspect of the course reinforcing knowledge and understanding of benefit to every paper studied.

## **Preparation**

To prepare for the course, we strongly recommend that you keep up to date with current ethical issues, debates and events around the world. We suggest that you read a broadsheet newspaper or relevant online publications on a regular basis and look out for philosophical and ethical discussion programmes (try "The Moral Maze" on Radio 4).

- What are the weakest aspects of Keown's argument?
